# Monens







### DESCRIPTION



Monensin is a polyether antibiotic of the ionophore group. It exerts an anticoccidial action against Eimeria tenella, E. acervulina, E. praecox, E. mitis, E. brunetti, E. maxima, E. necatrix in chickens. Its action is connected with the formation of lipophilic complexes with monovalent ions (sodium and potassium), making the membranes of the coccoidal cells permeable to the ions mentioned.

## **DIRECTION FOR USE**

For prevention of coccidiosis in chickens. Thoroughly mix the product into feed to obtain a concentration of 90 ~ 110 g monensin per ton of feed.



- 1. Do not feed to laying or breeder hens in production. Do not feed to chickens over 16 weeks old.
- 2. Do not use the product directly. Thoroughly mix the product into feed.
- 3. Do not use together with Tiamulin, Oleandomycin to avoid poisoning.
- 4. Do not use for equines.
- 5. Avoid skin and eye contact.

Withdrawal Period: 5 days Package 25kg/bag Storage conditions: Store in a cool, dry and well-ventilated area Shelf life: 2 years
